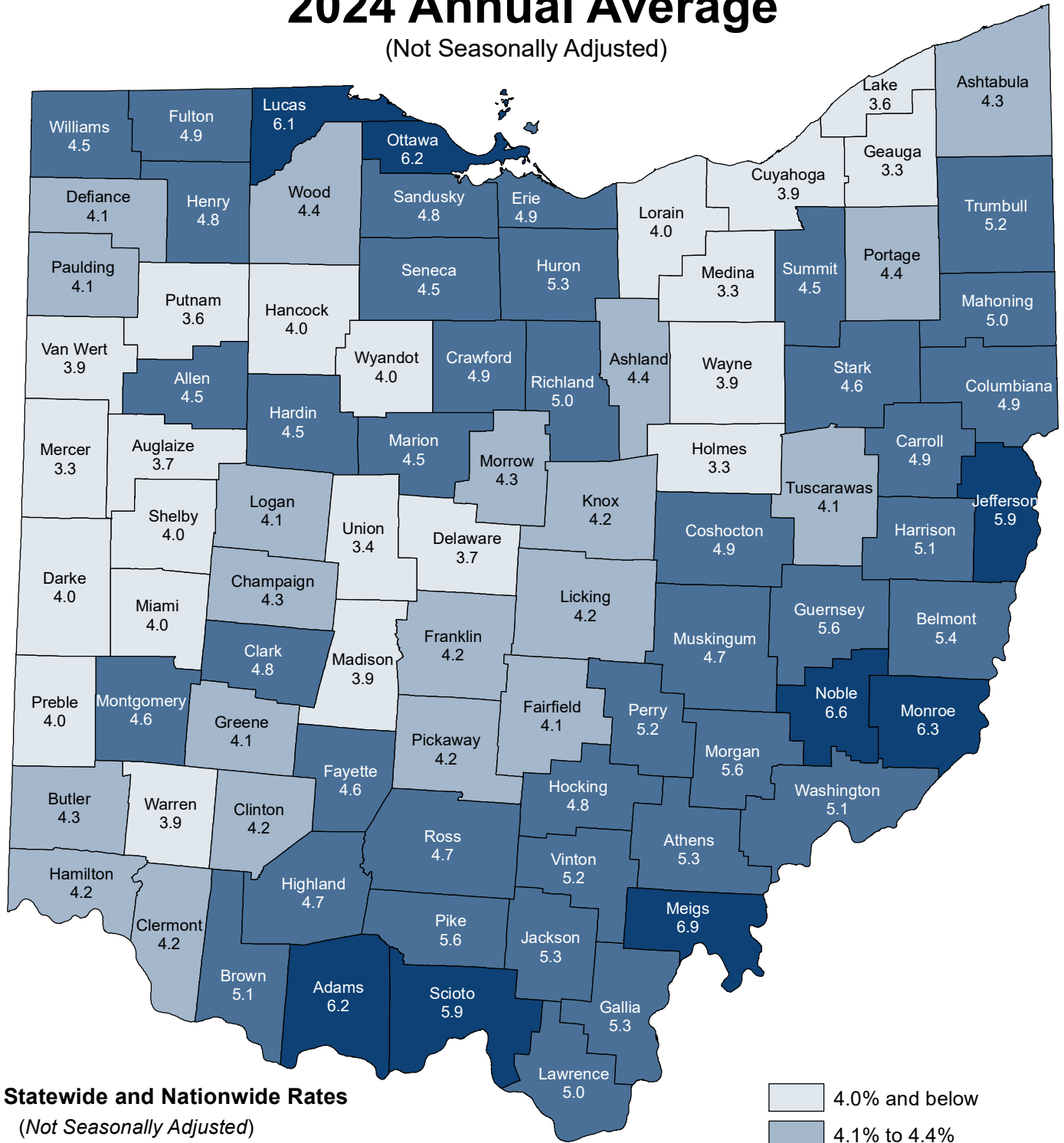


Ohio Unemployment Rates 2024 Annual Average

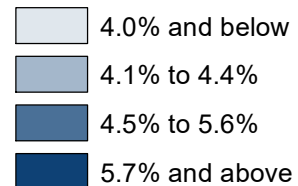
