

February 2019 Snapshot of Help Wanted OnLine® Internship Ads

A total of 834 internship ads were posted online from January 14, 2019, through February 13, 2019, for southwest Ohio. This was an increase of 28 ads from the previous reporting period and an increase of 248 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. The graph below shows historical trends for internship ads posted in this area over the last several years.
