A total of 3,529 internship ads were posted online from September 14, 2023, through October 13, 2023, for Ohio. This was an increase of 549 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 3,196 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
