A total of 835 internship ads were posted online from November 14, 2023, through December 13, 2023, for central Ohio. This was an increase of 84 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 478 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
