

## January 2024

A total of 448 internship ads were posted online from December 14, 2023, through January 13, 2024, for west Ohio. This was an increase of 56 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 153 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. EDITOR'S NOTE: This report is based on data provided by TalentNeuron Gartner<sup>™</sup>, a global research and advisory company. Through this partnership, new data sources and improved methodologies are available to better understand occupational demand over time. Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including reduced employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
