# Online Internship Postings in the Central JobsOhio Network

A total of 994 internship ads were posted online from February 14, 2024, through March 13, 2024, for central Ohio. This was an increase of 66 ads from the previous reporting period and a decrease of 645 ads compared to the same time period a year ago. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
