A total of 14,925 job openings were posted online from October 14, 2021, through November 13, 2021, for Adams, Athens, Belmont, Carroll, Coshocton, Gallia, Guernsey, Harrison, Highland, Hocking, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Lawrence, Meigs, Monroe, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble, Perry, Pike, Ross, Scioto, Vinton and Washington counties. This was an increase of 431 ads from the previous reporting period. Compared to the same time period a year ago, this reflects an increase of 1,447 ads. The graph below shows historical trends for ads posted in this area over the last several years.

Seasonal variation in employment occurs for natural and institutional reasons, including reduced employment involving outdoor activities during winter, changes in labor force and unemployment levels with opening and closing of schools, and layoffs during the automobile model changeover period. Seasonal variations can also affect the number of online job ads, so over the year it will affect the data in this report.
