# **Buckeyes & Bakeries**

In 2023, Ohio had more than **500 bakeries and baked goods stores.**

Buckeyes are peanut butter fudge balls dipped in chocolate. The finished product resembles the nut that grows on the Ohio buckeye tree.

#### **Ingredients:**

1 ½ cups peanut butter

½ cup margarine or ½ cup butter

1 lb. powdered sugar

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 ½ cups chocolate chips

Use  $\frac{1}{2}$  tsp of shortening per oz of chocolate instead of paraffin wax.

**Directions:** Mix peanut butter, softened margarine or butter, powdered sugar, and vanilla in bowl. Shape into 1" balls.

Meanwhile, melt chocolate in a double boiler. (The shortening will cause the chocolate to harden.)

Insert toothpick into refrigerated balls and dip into chocolate, leaving small area resembling a buckeye. Cool on wax paper and store in refrigerator or freezer.
