

Weekly Analysis

January 19, 2019

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 12,355 last week, an increase of 21.7 percent from the prior week's figure of 10,156 and a 23.6 percent increase from the January 2018 weekly average of 9,992. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 127. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 71,403 last week, a decrease of 2.6 percent from the prior week's figure of 73,286 and a 9.9 percent decrease from the January 2018 weekly average of 79,213. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 741. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
