

Weekly Analysis

February 9, 2019

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 6,577 last week, a decrease of 22.0 percent from the prior week's figure of 8,437 and a 2.5 percent decrease from the February 2018 weekly average of 6,746. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 24. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 74,366 last week, an increase of 1.9 percent from the prior week's figure of 73,010 and a 6.3 percent decrease from the February 2018 weekly average of 79,352. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 314. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
