

Weekly Analysis

April 13, 2019

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 5,235 last week, a decrease of 12.9 percent from the prior week's figure of 6,010 and a 11.2 percent decrease from the April 2018 weekly average of 5,893. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 19. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 54,919 last week, a decrease of 7.8 percent from the prior week's figure of 59,561 and a 17.2 percent decrease from the April 2018 weekly average of 66,344. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 215. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
