

Weekly Analysis

August 3, 2019

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 4,918 last week, a decrease of 0.6 percent from the prior week's figure of 4,949 and a 6.9 percent increase from the August 2018 weekly average of 4,599. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 16. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 43,785 last week, a decrease of 3.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 45,288 and a 12.6 percent increase from the August 2018 weekly average of 38,876. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 221. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
