

Weekly Analysis

August 24, 2019

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 4,932 last week, an increase of 5.9 percent from the prior week's figure of 4,657 and a 7.2 percent increase from the August 2018 weekly average of 4,599. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 21. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 41,038 last week, a decrease of 2.9 percent from the prior week's figure of 42,244 and a 5.6 percent increase from the August 2018 weekly average of 38,876. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 222. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
