

Weekly Analysis

April 4, 2020

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 226,007 last week, a decrease of 17.6 percent from the prior week's figure of 274,215 and a 3893.4 percent increase from the April 2019 weekly average of 5,660. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 183. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 449,999 last week, an increase of 110.1 percent from the prior week's figure of 214,229 and a 818.8 percent increase from the April 2019 weekly average of 48,974. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 410. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
