

Weekly Analysis

May 2, 2020

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 61,083 last week, a decrease of 34.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 92,920 and a 780.7 percent increase from the May 2019 weekly average of 6,935. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 56. Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC08) initial claims totaled zero. Federal-State Extended Benefits (EB) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 758,059 last week, a decrease of 2.3 percent from the prior week's figure of 776,302 and a 1816.2 percent increase from the May 2019 weekly average of 39,560. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 606. EUC continued claims totaled zero while EB continued claims totaled zero.
