

Weekly Analysis

June 6, 2020

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 35,427 last week, an increase of 2.5 percent from the prior week's figure of 34,566 and a 454.6 percent increase from the June 2019 weekly average of 6,388. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 47. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled 40,133.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 515,583 last week, a decrease of 6.4 percent from the prior week's figure of 550,989 and a 883.7 percent increase from the June 2019 weekly average of 52,413. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 505. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 13,899 while PUA continued claims totaled 562,418.
