

Weekly Analysis

June 25, 2022

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 13,482 last week, an increase of 23.7 percent from the prior week's figure of 10,895 and a 2.1 percent increase from the June 2021 weekly average of 13,204. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 19. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled 5.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 32,612 last week, a decrease of 2.0 percent from the prior week's figure of 33,261 and a 58.6 percent decrease from the June 2021 weekly average of 78,832. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 154. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 22 while PUA continued claims totaled 1,085. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
