

Weekly Analysis

May 20, 2023

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 8,193 last week, an increase of 3.8 percent from the prior week's figure of 7,896 and a 1.5 percent decrease from the May 2022 weekly average of 8,320. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 21. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 38,919 last week, a decrease of 2.5 percent from the prior week's figure of 39,922 and a 17.4 percent increase from the May 2022 weekly average of 33,162. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 133. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 38 while PUA continued claims totaled 108. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
