

Weekly Analysis

May 27, 2023

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 10,355 last week, an increase of 26.4 percent from the prior week's figure of 8,193 and a 24.5 percent increase from the May 2022 weekly average of 8,320. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 15. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 39,105 last week, an increase of 0.5 percent from the prior week's figure of 38,919 and a 17.9 percent increase from the May 2022 weekly average of 33,162. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 139. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 37 while PUA continued claims totaled zero. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
