

Weekly Analysis

September 9, 2023

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 7,159 last week, a decrease of 32.0 percent from the prior week's figure of 10,535 and a 5.7 percent increase from the September 2022 weekly average of 6,775. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 10. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 35,116 last week, a decrease of 3.4 percent from the prior week's figure of 36,357 and a 35.8 percent increase from the September 2022 weekly average of 25,855. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 114. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 28 while PUA continued claims totaled zero. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
