

Weekly Analysis

October 7, 2023

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 6,084 last week, a decrease of 12.4 percent from the prior week's figure of 6,948 and a 10.1 percent decrease from the October 2022 weekly average of 6,765. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 18. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 35,306 last week, an increase of 0.6 percent from the prior week's figure of 35,095 and a 12.3 percent increase from the October 2022 weekly average of 31,447. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 83. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 31 while PUA continued claims totaled zero. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
