

Weekly Analysis

April 27, 2024

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 5,018 last week, an increase of 7.1 percent from the prior week's figure of 4,685 and a 36.3 percent decrease from the April 2023 weekly average of 7,883. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 13. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 40,708 last week, a decrease of 6.7 percent from the prior week's figure of 43,635 and a 22.3 percent decrease from the April 2023 weekly average of 52,388. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 141. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 22 while PUA continued claims totaled 50. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
