

Weekly Analysis

May 25, 2024

Ohio Law initial claims, representing newly unemployed persons, totaled 4,638 last week, a decrease of 10.6 percent from the prior week's figure of 5,187 and a 48.8 percent decrease from the May 2023 weekly average of 9,058. Initial claims under Title 5 of the U.S. Code (UCFE & UCX) totaled 14. Pandemic Unemployment Compensation (PUA) initial claims totaled zero.

Ohio Law continued claims, representing persons unemployed one week or more, totaled 37,415 last week, a decrease of 1.6 percent from the prior week's figure of 38,005 and a 0.2 percent decrease from the May 2023 weekly average of 37,508. Continued claims under Title 5 totaled 168. Pandemic Emergency Unemployment Compensation (PEUC) continued claims totaled 5 while PUA continued claims totaled zero. Extended Benefits (EB) continued claims totaled zero.
